1. John earns 200 dollars per week. How much does he earn in 4 weeks?



2. The price of a calculator is 25 dollars. What is the price of 5 calculators?

3. Tigers have 2 ears. How many ears do 60 tigers have?



4. I earned 400 dollars last month. This month I earned twice that amount. How much did I earn this month?

5. I eat about 8 ice-creams per week. How many ice-creams do I eat in 20 weeks?



6. I can pick 150 apples per day. How many apples can I pick in 4 days?

Answers

Solve the following word problems. Show number sentence and your workings.

1. John earns 200 dollars per week. How much does he earn in 4 weeks?

$$4 \times 200 = 800 \text{ dollars}$$



2. The price of a calculator is 25 dollars. What is the price of 5 calculators?

$$5 \times 25 = 125 \text{ dollars}$$

3. Tigers have 2 ears. How many ears do 60 tigers have?

$$2 \times 60 = 120 \text{ ears}$$



4. I earned 400 dollars last month. This month I earned twice that amount. How much did I earn this month?

$$2 \times 400 = 800 \text{ dollars}$$

5. I eat about 8 ice-creams per week. How many ice-creams do I eat in 20 weeks?

$$8 \times 20 = 160 \text{ ice-creams}$$



6. I can pick 150 apples per day. How many apples can I pick in 4 days?

$$4 \times 150 = 600 \text{ apples}$$
