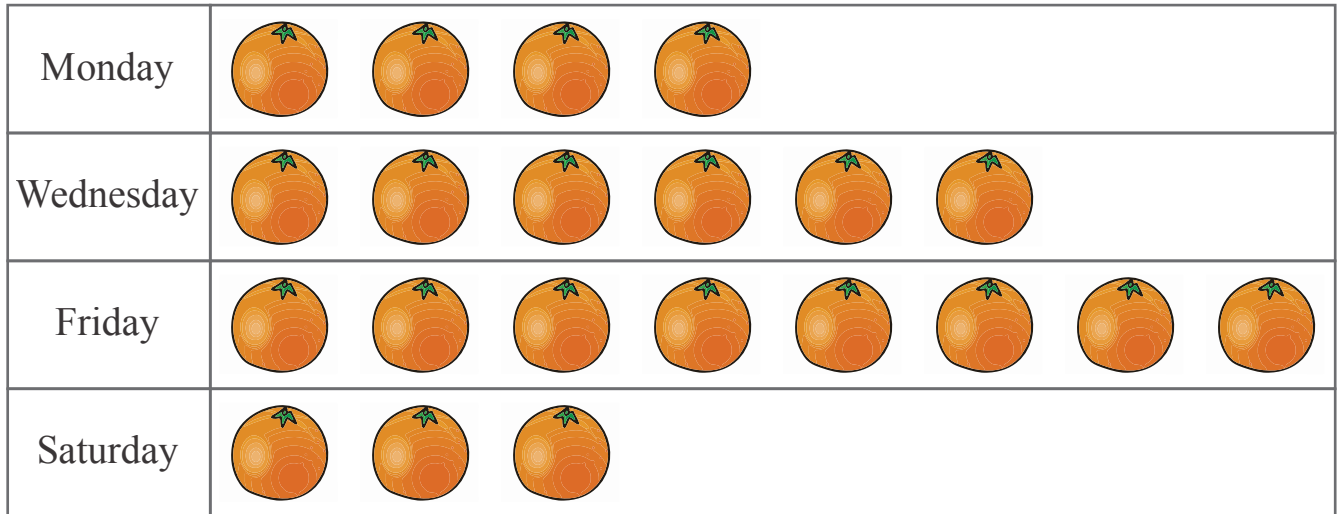


Making Orange Juice

Peter likes to pick oranges and squeeze them into fresh juice that he can kindly share with his friends. The picture graph shows how many oranges he picked on certain days.

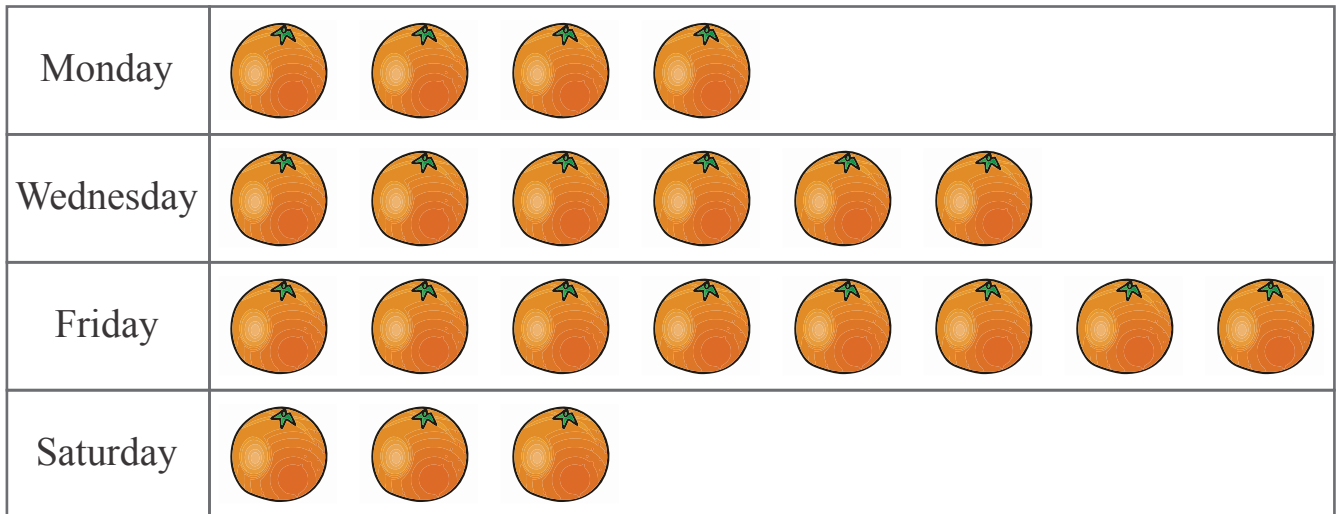


Each  stands for 15 oranges

- 1) How many oranges did Peter pick on Wednesday and Friday?
- 2) How many oranges did he pick on the other 2 days?
- 3) How many more oranges did he pick on Friday than on Saturday?
- 4) On which day did he pick twice as many oranges as on Monday?
- 5) On which day did Peter pick 45 oranges more than on Saturday?
- 6) Peter needs 9 oranges for 1 liter of orange juice. How many liters of juice can he make on Saturday?
