


A bookshop made a line graph of the number of books it sold per week during a certain period. Use the information to answer the questions.



- 1) How many books were sold in week 2?
- 2) How many books were sold in week 3 and 4?
- 3) How many books were sold in week 5, 6 and 7?
- 4) How many more books were sold in week 7 than 8?
- 5) How many books were sold in all 8 weeks?
- 6) What was the average number of books that were sold each week?

Answers

A bookshop made a line graph of the number of books it sold per week during a certain period. Use the information to answer the questions.



1) How many books were sold in week 2?

120 books

2) How many books were sold in week 3 and 4?

210 books

3) How many books were sold in week 5, 6 and 7?

240 books

4) How many more books were sold in week 7 than 8?

80 books

5) How many books were sold in all 8 weeks?

640 books

6) What was the average number of books that were sold each week?

$640 \div 8 = 80$ books
