$$1,999 + 2,999 = 4,998$$

3. A new computer costs 2,000 dollars. Jill has already 765 dollars. How much more money does she need?



$$2,000 - 765 = 1,235$$
 dollars

4. John earned 2,500 dollars in November. In December he earned 500 dollars more than in November. How much did John earn in both months?

$$2,500 + (2,500 + 500) = 5,500$$
 dollars

5. Jamie spent 1,150 dollars on a watch and 850 dollars on a phone. How much money did Jamie spend altogether?



$$1,150 + 850 = 2,000 \text{ dollars}$$

6. Peter earned 950 dollars in March and 1,250 dollars in April. How much more did he earn in April than in March?

$$1,250 - 950 = 300 \text{ dollars}$$

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
