## puzzle 1 : 13

The difference between the opposite numbers is 7 . The shapes follow a 5, 6, 7 difference pattern.

## puzzle 2: C

The 3rd square is formed by subtracting the shaded dots of the 2 nd square from the 1 st.

## puzzle 3: 3

3 and the opposite 4 make 7 . Multiply by 2 to give the middle number.

## puzzle 4: 3

3 and 5 add up to the 8 in the middle and 3 and 6 to 9 .
